

The journey is a blend of breathtaking **panoramas** — **snow-capped peaks** piercing clear blue skies, vast frozen deserts, and silent valleys **blanketed in snow**. Adventure lies in every twist and turn on these treacherous roads, demanding skill, focus, and teamwork as you navigate icy switchbacks and snowdrifts. And if luck is on your side, you may glimpse rare wildlife — the elusive snow leopard stalking the cliffs, blue sheep grazing in the frosty highlands, or Himalayan birds weaving through the cold mountain air. This expedition is more than a drive — it's a deep dive into Spiti's wild heart, where culture, nature, and adventure collide in unforgettable ways.


Beginning of great adventures



Day 1- Shimla to Narkanda



Arrive in Shimla and begin your journey towards Narkanda or Sarahan. driving through beautiful forested hills, pine-covered slopes, and winding Himalayan roads as you gradually enter the cooler, quieter landscapes of upper Himachal.



Day 2- Narkanda to Kalpa

After an early breakfast, Narkanda to Kalpa is a scenic 8–9 hour drive via Narkanda, Rampur, Jeori, and Reckong Peo, with apple orchards and the Sutlej river along the way. In Kalpa, stay at a place facing the Kinner Kailash for stunning sunrise and sunset views. Explore Suicide Point, Roghi Village, Hu-Bu-Lan-Kar Monastery, and enjoy peaceful walks through the market and orchards.







Day 3- Kalpa to Tabo



we begin our journey from Kalpa to Tabo, entering the stunning and rugged landscapes of the Spiti Valley. Drive through remote highmountain roads, crossing villages like Puh, Khab (at the confluence of Sutlej and Spiti Rivers), and Nako. Take a break at Nako Lake before continuing toward Tabo. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel or homestay and relax.

Day 4- Tabo to Kaza

In the morning, explore the local sights of Tabo. Then, drive to Dhankar Village and continue your journey towards kaza,arriving in Kaza by the evening.



"Spiti Valley, recently recognized as a Rare Wildlife Reserve by UNESCO World Heritage, is one of the last untouched high-altitude ecosystems on Earth. At the heart of this reserve lies Kibber, a remote village that offers a rare and unparalleled opportunity to witness the elusive Snow Leopard and other unique Himalayan species in their natural habitat."

We have local Snow leopards expeditions leader on ground tracking throughout winter, if there is possibility we may get a chance.

Day 5- Kaza Local Sightseeing

Experience the best of Spiti in a single unforgettable day as you start from Kaza and ride through Langza's giant Buddha overlooking the valley, drive up to Komik—one of the world's highest villages—stop at Hikkim to post a letter from the highest post office, cross the dramatic gorge at Chicham Bridge, visit the serene high-altitude village of Kibber, and end your journey with a peaceful sunset at the iconic Key Monastery.

Day 6- kaza to Sangla

Kaza to Sangla on one of the most dramatic drives in the Himalayas, crossing remote cold-desert landscapes, passing through villages like Tabo or Sumdo, and entering the lush green beauty of Kinnaur as you descend towards Sangla; the route gradually shifts from barren Spiti terrain to pine forests, apple orchards, and the soothing Baspa River, giving you a perfect mix of adventure, scenic contrasts, and a peaceful evening in the charming Sangla Valley.

Day 7- Sangla to Shimla



Today we drive from Sangla to Chitkul later towards Shimla, depending on your further travel plans. Upon arrival, our coordinators will ensure a smooth and comfortable transition to your onward journey or designated drop-off point.





Things to carry

Clothing: Insulated jacket, hoodie thermals (2-3 pairs) fleece layers, gloves (warm & waterproof), woolen socks, warm cap, mask, windproof & waterproof layers.
